Welcome to **Walks into Conservation History for Seniors!** In this free program we will visit special lands in Marin that were acquired over many years to protect their plants and wildlife, and for people to enjoy. Our focus is on Marin County's Open Space Preserves, but we will visit other public lands as well.

We will transport you by van – or meet you at the Trailhead if you choose – walk on easy trails, talk about how the lands were saved, introduce you to plants and wildlife, and enjoy a light snack. Van capacity is 20, and reservations are required for all participants.

## Old St. Hilary's Open Space Preserve, Tiburon Friday, June 10

Enjoy unsurpassed views of the Bay from the southern ridges of Tiburon Peninsula. Old St. Hilary's Open Space Preserve, saved by local activists in the 1990s, adjoins the Tiburon Uplands Nature Preserve and privately-owned lands of the Martha Company.

Directions: take Tiburon Blvd (State Route 131) from 101, drive to "downtown" Tiburon traffic light at Beach Rd. Left on Beach Rd, continue for a few blocks and turn left on Esperanza St. (a sign points to Old St. Hilary's church). Ample parking at the church.
